S:T JACOBS VOCAL ENSEMBLE - Sweden



and in collaboration with other musicians.

S:t Jacobs Vocal Ensemble is a mixed choir consisting of 40 singers ages 20 to 32 from Stockholm. The majority of their concerts and activities are held in the church of St Jacob (Saint James) and in the Stockholm Cathedral. The choir gives special and diverse performances on stage that are firmly focused in the Swedish choral tradition. They believe that classical choral singing can develop in a modern and interesting direction without losing its unique qualities. Since it was founded, the choir has been conducted by Mikael Wedar, highly experienced in teaching choral singing – e.g. at Stockholm's Musikgymnasium. S:t Jacobs Vocal Ensemble has weekly rehearsals, participates in Sunday services a number of times a year, gives concerts both in its own right

ESTUDIO CORAL MERIDIES – Argentina

The Estudio Coral Meridies was formed in 2004 by Virginia Bono as an independent amateur artistic ensemble. Since its creation, Meridies (Latin word for "South") has set as its goal as the intensive study of not just the vast choral repertoire but rather focusing on performing and premiering choral works by contemporary Argentinean and South American composers. Meridies has received recognition from both the public and from specialists for its rich sound, musicality and exquisite interpretations. For their good work and high level, the choir has become one of the most representative choirs of South-America and ambassador of its culture. Estudio Coral Meridies has recorded 3 CDs of Argentinian music and the choir has

been recognized with numerous awards and distinctions.

ST. STANISLAV GIRLS' CHOIR LJUBLJANA - Slovenia

St. Stanislav's Girls' Choir is one of the five choirs at the Diocesan Classical Gymnasium in Ljubljana (Slovenia). Singers are between the ages of 16 and 19. Since this is the school choir, each year one third of the choir changes. The choir fosters a very versatile repertoire from classical choral masterpieces of various periods, Slovenian contemporary compositions, vocal pop, and Slovenian folk songs and dances. They pride themselves on premiere performances of choral pieces written especially for them by contemporary Slovenian composers such as Damijan Močnik and Ambrož Čopi. They have received a number of gold plaques, first place awards and special honors in national and international competitions.



WISHFUL SINGING - Netherlands



Wishful Singing is a top-ranking international a cappella ensemble consisting of five young female singers from the Netherlands. Their repertoire covers all variety of styles. Whether performing a tranquil Renaissance harmony or a funky arrangement of a classic pop song, this quintet engages their audience through their powerful expression, and flawless vocal blend with humor and theatrical elements. The members of Wishful Singing aim to share their expertise and love of music by offering workshops to other choirs and ensembles and are actively involved in music education and recently developed an educational program that is designed to be spread over a number of years of primary school education. Wishful Singing members include Anne-Christine Wemekamp (S1), Maria Goetze (S2), Marjolein Verburg (Mz), Annemiek van der Ven (A1), Marjolein Stots (A2).

CONDUCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS (CWB) DECEMBER 2016 SESSION IN LOME, TOGO

The second CWB session was organized in Lome, Togo, from December 13 to 18, 2016, thanks to the Togolese Association of Choral Composers (Sylvain Gameti, President), A Cœur Joie International (ACJI) and the International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM). The instructor was Thierry Thiébaut, ACJI President and IFCM Board member. This session was intended to evaluate the participants to establish courses which match the needs of the region and will be part of a three years training program, including a special program to teach local instructors as it is the case in DR Congo, Ivory Coast, Gabon and Senegal. 15 trainees and 35 singers attended this December session. CONDUCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS (CWB) JANUARY 2017 SESSION IN LIBREVILLE, GABON

The seventh CWB session was organized in Libreville, Gabon, from January 9 to 14, 2017, thanks to the local choral federation and its President Yveline Damas. Unfortunately due to the political circumstances at the end of last year in Gabon and other financial factors, only one instructor could be hired to supervise the session, which modified the framework of teaching. 16 trainees including 14 of the last session in March participated in the session. Seven of them have the pedagogical and musical potential to become local instructors. Some projects in collaboration with the French Institute of Libreville have been discussed. Among them, a singing program for children, a performance for choir and orchestra (Vivaldi's *Gloria* and Pachelbel's *Magnificat*), and the 8th CWB training session in May or June. VALE VELJO TORMIS

Composer Veljo Tormis, who was one of the most important Estonian composers has died at the age of 86. Tormis was internationally regarded as one of the greatest choral music writers in the modern era, and one of the most important composers of the 20th century in Estonia.

Tormis's contribution to the Estonian choral tradition and to choral music worldwide is invaluable. One can say he created a choral tradition of his own, the unique "Tormis' style". From his student days until his retirement from composition in 2000, Tormis composed over 500 individual choral songs, as well as other vocal and instrumental pieces, 35 film scores and an opera.
