NEWS FROM THE 11TH WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC

BARCELONA, 22 - 29 JULY 2017

As the Mediterranean summer gets closer, Barcelona is taking care of the last details to welcome the plurality of our choral worldwide community and host the colors of peace. We will enjoy more than 60 concerts, over 70 lectures and presentations, 4 master classes, and a Choral Expo with leading publishers. Participants from more than 40 countries across the world are already registered and you won't want to miss a Symposium that promises to be unforgettable!

Here are four more choirs that will participate at the "Circle Concerts" of the WSCM11:



ELLERHEIN GIRLS' CHOIR – Estonia

Since 2012 Ingrid Kõrvits has been the chief conductor. Over the past decade, various choral festivals and competitions have led the choir to 12 different countries around the world and the choir has won numerous awards, including Grand Prix in three of them. In 2004, Ellerhein in collaboration with Paavo Järvi received a Grammy award (for best choral performance), awarded for the disc "Sibelius: cantatas" (Virgin Classics). Last season the choir had many different and exciting projects with repertoire ranging from Estonian choral classics to Mendelssohn's "A Midsummer Night's Dream".

THE RAFFLES SINGERS – Singapore

Conducted by Toh Ban Sheng, The Raffles Singers have clinched top honours in international competitions and festivals in Europe. The choir was awarded a perfect-score Gold Diploma and Category Champion at the 34th International Festival of Songs Olomouc in 2006. The following year, they were awarded a Gold Diploma at the17th International Festival of Advent and Christmas Music in Prague. Most recently, in 2015, the choir flew Singapore's flag high at the 3rd International Copernicus Choir Festival and Competition in Torun, Poland, emerging as the Grand Prix winner.





MIXED CHOIR KULKUSET – Finland

Sekakuoro Kulkuset was founded in the aftermath of Finnish independence in January 1918. It is one of the oldest mixed choirs in Finland performing mainly a cappella with a versatile repertoire. Finnish music has, of course, always been very important for the choir, but their repertoire draws from many different sources and today includes material from early music to contemporary compositions. The choir has also commissioned compositions and arrangements from many contemporary Finnish composers.



Since most Dongs prefer their towns or villages to be relatively small, in which usually twenty to thirty households constitute a village, Dong songs vary from village to village. One may discover that popular songs from neighbouring villages can be quite different. Since one cannot easily travel to the Dong villages, this is the perfect opportunity for international folk choral music lovers, and culture explorers to explore this interesting and unique heritage. Not only will you be able to hear the songs of the Dong and Miao people of this region, you will be able to explore some world renowned choirs singing folk songs indigenous to their own countries.

The international jury meeting for session 2017 took place in Pécs between 16-18 of March where the representatives of the three patron organization (IFCM, ECA-EC and JMI) together with the conductors of the session selected the best singers from nearly 200 candidates. The international jury chose 55 singers from 33 countries to be part of the World Youth Choir for the upcoming summer session, located in Pécs with a concert tour in Serbia, Bosnia and Herzegovina, Slovenia, Croatia and Hungary. Thank you very much to all the recruiters who have been informed about the selection results at the same time as the singers.

NEWS FROM IFCM FOUNDING MEMBERS

AMERICAN CHORAL DIRECTORS ASSOCIATION - ACDA

The American Choral Directors Association is collaborating with the Robert Shaw website to scan the bulk of the 125 scores in ACDA's archives that Robert Shaw used in preparation for rehearsal scores and materials. The scores were donated to ACDA in 2015. According to Tim Share, ACDA executive director, "These treasures have different levels of marking and were used for different purposes to help Mr. Shaw convey to his singers exactly what he wanted them to do with every note. These scores offer significant insight into Robert Shaw's analytical and score-marking process." This collaborative project has produced six additional digitized scores over the past few months, and will continue for some time into the future. One million euro over four years for collective singing in Europe

The European Choral Association - Europa Cantat is happy to share the news that its application for Network Funding under the EU Creative Europe programme has been successful!

The project "Upgrade - Connect - Reach out: Raising Awareness for Collective Singing in Europe" will be funded by the EU with up to 250.000 EUR per year over four years (09/2017 to 08/2021).

Developed in tight cooperation with the membership, the project aims at strengthening the network and its members, connect to and cooperate with other players in the field of Collective Singing and beyond, reach out to people who do not sing (yet) and promote the value of European cooperation.
