# 2017 CHINA (QIANDONGNAN) INTERNATIONAL FOLK SONG CHORAL FESTIVAL AND IFCM WORLD VOICES CONFERENCE KAILI CITY, 8-13 August 2017



On 14 May 2017, a successful press conference was held in Shanghai promoting the upcoming 2017 China (Qiandongnan) International Folk Song Choral Festival and IFCM World Voices Conference. During the press conference, music professionals and news/media outlets from China and abroad were able to experience the rich culture of the Miao and Dong people. Through a special live performance of their songs and dance, attendees observed the passion they have for song and dance and their role in daily life. Miao and Dong people have

colourful costuming that is native to each village and tribe; these costumes are rich in colour and are hand-embroidered to show each village's colours. Known for their silver hand-made jewellery, Miao and Dong people wear astonishing headpieces, pins, necklaces, bracelets, and other accessories all crafted in, that make their costumes dazzle for the audience.

During this festival, as delegates learn about the Miao and Dong people, they will also discover other folk cultures from around the world. As part of the IFCM World Voices Conference, the Barents Ensemble (Lapland), Voz en Punto (Mexico), Dalinda Vocal Group (Sweden), Kentucky Harmony (USA) and The Chuck Nation Band (USA) will perform concerts to promote the importance of folk culture exchange and education. Participants will observe lectures given by world-renowned ethnomusicologists including Márta Sebestyen (Hungary), Katarina Barruk (Sweden), Karen Brunssen (USA), Allen Henderson (USA), Samir Bahajin (Morocco), and Sylvie Le Bomin (Benin). Assisting Philip Brunelle, Co-Artistic Director for this Festival, was Gan Lin, Co-Artistic Director, and representatives from IFCM's Founding Members, Gábor Móczár from the European Choral Association-Europa Cantat (ECA-EC), Tim Sharp from the American Choral Directors Association (ACDA), and Thierry Thiébaut of Coeur Joie International (ACI).

## **WORLD YOUTH CHOIR**

#### The Summer Session is getting nearer!

The summer session and tour of the World Youth Choir in 2017 will be organized in Pécs, Hungary, by the Zsolnay Heritage Management Nonprofit Ltd, the cultural holding of the city that hosted EUROPA CANTAT in 1988 and 2015. Following a 10 days intensive rehearsal session in Pécs (4-13 July) with two internationally renowned conductors, the World Youth Choir will start its tour of 12 concerts on 13 July at the Kodály Centre of Pécs in Hungary followed by concerts in Hungary (Budapest), Serbia (Sombor, Novi Sad, Belgrade), Bosnia and Herzegovina (Sarajevo, Prijedor), Croatia (Osijek, a Dalmatian city, Opatija) and in Slovenia (Koper, Ljubljana). In the framework of the "Artist for Peace" theme there shall be strong emphasis on reconciliation among different ethnic groups and religions.

This year the choir will comprise of 58 singers from 33 countries all over the world and shall perform a repertoire of two different musical genres. Zoltán Pad from Hungary will conduct classical and contemporary pieces, folk arrangements and church music (Mendelssohn, Forte, Orbán, Kodály, Tajcevic), with a number of songs selected from the visited countries. Ken Wakia from Kenya will conduct African folk tunes, African-American spirituals, and contemporary world music (music by Shawn Kirchner, Jake Runestad, Michael Barrett and Ralf Schmitt, Allen Koepke, Stacey V. Gibbs, Leonard Cohen and Evan Powers).

### **EUROPEAN CHORAL ASSOCIATION - EUROPA CANTAT (ECA-EC)**

Singing "outside the box" to meet new audiences

#### The project awarded by the Creative Europe programme

How can collective singing get out of conventional choral venues and reach out to new audiences? How can collective singing appeal to younger generations? What aspects of the rehearsal process, of the repertoire, of the performance could be upgraded to better answer the expectations of millennials and of the following generation?

"Sing Outside The Box" will test innovative audience development methods during two sessions of the <u>Eurochoir</u> and different ateliers and concerts at the <u>EUROPA CANTAT Festival</u> in Tallinn

and disseminate these methods to multipliers.

The Eurochoir is a European choir gathering up to 60 talented emerging singers. Its sessions are held once a year in a different country. A 2 years cycle was set up, under the supervision of acclaimed conductors: Maria van Nieukerken (NL), Lorenzo Donati (IT) and Mikko Sidoroff (FI).

After the sessions 2017 (Utrecht) and 2018 (Helsinki), the choir will present its work as special guest of the EUROPA CANTAT festival 2018 in Tallinn. The themes of the project will also be developed along the festival, with 3 ateliers for singers and 10 workshops for conductors dedicated to the themes:

- Go out and meet new audiences: Use of unusual concert venues, concerts in the frame of non-choral or even non-musical events
- Staging: Develop innovative approaches to staging, with a focus on the specific abilities of singers as instruments (movement, sound spatialisation, blending in the audience, etc.).
- Technical development: use of lighting and sound reinforcement as an artistic element
- Pedagogy: foster access for non readers, non trained singers, to discover the fun of collective singing.
- Involve choirs, conductors and singers in an active recruiting process of active and passive audiences

Leveraging the prescriptive power of the Eurochoir, of the EUROPA CANTAT festival, and the power of the European Choral network (and two of its international conferences), the project will help redefine a new benchmark for collective singing.

#### **NEWS FROM IFCM MEMBERS**

#### **OBITUARY: PROF. WALDO ARÁNGUIZ**

The international choral world is sad about the loss of Prof. Waldo Aránguiz at the age of 90. His reputation as composer, conductor and choral leader has spread far beyond the borders of Chile. He was very active on the international choral scene and a faithful supporter of the International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM). In 1982, he organized the Chilean delegation that came to Namur, Belgium, for the creation of IFCM and was appointed to the Board of Directors to represent one of the IFCM Founding Members at that time, the Asociación Interamericana de Directores de Coros (AIDC). He remained on the IFCM Board until 1998 and IFCM advisor until 2008. He was also a faithful participant and lecturer of IFCM symposia.

Despite his numerous activities, Prof. Aránguiz still found the time to help as a volunteer author and translator of the IFCM International Choral Bulletin (ICB).

In 1996, he took part in the creation of ALACC, the Latin-American Choral Music Association and was elected President for two consecutive mandates. In 2002, he became President of the Chilean Music Council and he was the conductors of five choirs. Waldo Aránguiz Thompson was a founding member of the World Choir Council at INTERKULTUR and a strong supporter of the Choral Olympic idea in South America.

His spirit will remain in the associations that he helped create and in the many people he inspired.
