

5TH IFCM INTERNATIONAL COMPOSITION COMPETITION 2022

In 2021, IFCM launched its **Fifth International Choral Composition Competition** to promote new works in choral music and to encourage innovation in choral writing that fits the needs of a 21st-century choir. Composers were invited to submit compositions that combine originality, imagination, and creativity within the context of contemporary global themes and in accordance with the published **Rules and Regulations**.

93 submissions were received: 74 for the Mixed Choir category and 19 for the World Choral Day category. The response included a broad representation from 38 countries:

- USA : 17 submissions
- Canada, Italy : 7 submissions from each country
- UK : 5 submissions from each country
- France, Indonesia, Spain : 4 submissions from each country
- Germany, Philippines, Venezuela : 3 submissions from each country
- Austria, Belgium, China, Hungary, New Zealand, Nigeria, South Korea, Turkey, Russia: 2 submissions from each country
- Australia, Brazil, Columbia, Croatia, Cuba, Cyprus, Finland, Greece, Hong Kong, Iceland, Iran, Ireland, Israel, Mozambique, North Korea, Netherlands, Portugal, Switzerland: 1 submission from each country

The competition was fully anonymous. The five jury members met in March 2022 and chose the winners according to the Rules and Regulations of the competition: Andrea Ramsey (chair, USA), Nana Forte (Slovenia), Onur Türkmen (Turkey), Miguel Astor (Venezuela), Ko Matsushita (Japan).

Building on the success of the *YEMP* program (*Young Event Management Program*) which the European Choral Association has organised for many years as part of Europa Cantat and the fact that IFCM currently has three employees who are former YEMPers, we want to provide an opportunity for young choral organisers from across the globe to gain experience on the spot as well as invest in the future of IFCM.

IFCM is happy to report 35 applications were received for this inaugural program. Representation from multiple countries reflected our international membership: Philippines (6); Russia (3); Estonia, German, Hungary, Latvia, Thailand (2); Argentina, Belgium, Canada, Iran, Italy, Japan, Lithuania, Morocco, Portugal, Turkey, Slovenia, Serbia, Ukraine, USA (1).

From the 35 applicants, the Selection Committee chose 10 that best fit the WCE program, those with motivation and the necessary skills in order to benefit from the *YOUNG* program. The committee also considered geographical and gender representation.
