IFCM OPENS A NEW BRANCH IN LISBON, PORTUGAL

2022 is a significant year for IFCM. Not only is it the celebration year of our 40th anniversary, but we have also reached several critical milestones in terms of the administration of our Federation.

In 2019, with the help and generosity of IFCM President, Mme Emily Kuo Vong, IFCM opened a new office in the magnificent historical building Palacete dos Condes de Monte Real (Rua Buenos Aires 39) in the heart of Lisbon, Portugal. During the past three years, most of our archives have been moved to this new office. Our goal has been to have the archives sorted and put online for the celebration of IFCM's 40th anniversary. We are delighted to announce that we have achieved this goal. Programs, books, recordings, membership records, lists of officers, and administration correspondence during the past 40 years are now sorted, adequately archived, and published online for future reference. We are happy that IFCM's history is now well preserved and available for future generations!

The second milestone fulfills our desire to have a legal headquarters in Europe. We are pleased to announce that IFCM has successfully opened a non-profit, legal branch of IFCM USA in Lisbon, Portugal. Having an IFCM branch within the European Union will be a huge benefit for all our European members and will allow our Federation to be more visible in Europe.

OBITUARY: CHRISTOPH KÜHLEWEIN (GERMANY)

We regretfully announce the passing of Christoph Kühlewein on 11 May 2022. Christoph was the Secretary General of the European Federation of Young Choirs (now European Choral Association) between 1976 and 1982. He later became a member of their Music Commission and then an advisor. Christoph conducted several choirs including a French-German choir in Paris.

Christoph was the father of Christina Kühlewein, IFCM project manager from 2006 till 2009. Our most sincere condolences go to Christina, and to Christoph's wife and family.





OBITUARY: ANDRÉ DUMONT (BELGIUM)

We regretfully announce the passing of André Dumont on 25 May 2022. André played an important role in the choral scene of Belgium.

Thanks to his support and vision, two Europa Cantat festivals were organized in 1964 and in 1982 in Namur, which would later be referred to as the Capital of Choral Music.

These festivals would respectively lead to the creation of the movement À Coeur Joie International in 1969 and the creation of the International Federation for Choral Music in 1982. André was Honorary President of À Cœur Joie International and Honorary President of the Choral Federation À Cœur Joie Wallonie-Bruxelles. He was a passionate supporter of choral singing and his contribution to the popularity of choral singing is an inspiration for all of us. Our most condolences go to his children, family and friends.

proforá is the answer to a frequent concern expressed by singers and choir conductors alike: how to pronounce (that is, correctly sing) vocal music in a foreign language? At proforá, you will find about 300 pronunciation tracks of solo and choral pieces in 12 languages, recorded by professional singers in their native languages. The files can be downloaded in several audio formats; single tracks start from € 0,99. Bundles are available for song cycles, oratorios, or collections. A special discount exists for choirs. The website is available in English, French, and German.
