CONDUCTORS WITHOUT BORDERS (CWB)

Last November, the third conductors' training session took place in Abidjan (Ivory Coast) with two instructors (Françoise Brunier (France) and Thierry Thiebaut (France), CWB Manager)

The session welcomed 18 conductors in the beginners' course and six in the intermediate level. One or two of these conductors will be able to start an instructor's mission in 2016.

During a meeting with the French Cultural Department in Abidjan, the French Foreign Minister offered to support the CWB program and will

fund four missions of one week in 2015 (two instructors for two weeks during the year)... The same Ministry had already sponsored the two CWB missions in October 2014.

In 2015, the CBW program will focus on new actions in Ghana and Nigeria in addition to the actual activities in DR Congo, Gabon, Ivory Coast, Morocco and Senegal.
