

## IFCM 2026 Call for IFCM Internal Financial Auditors



**The International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM) calls for candidates to fill positions of the IFCM internal financial auditors for the three-year term beginning in August 2026.**

In accordance with [IFCM's Internal Membership Policy](#), the Federation's membership will be required to elect a new Board of Directors and a President in 2026. In addition, the membership will elect internal financial auditors. These elections will be conducted **online** before the World on Choral Music in Macau, China, and the General Assembly scheduled for 23 August 2026.

According to Article 12.2 in Internal Membership Policy Document:

The General Assembly shall appoint one or two internal auditors to make fiscal and activity audits of the organization on behalf of the membership. These internal auditors shall not be current members of the Board.

The responsibilities of these auditors shall be:

- a. To examine fiscal reports and information about balances of the books.
  - b. To check the legitimate use of the resources of the Federation.
  - c. To check that resources have been used in agreement with the regulations of the Federation.
  - d. To give a report of such audits to the Board and the ExCom.
  - e. The Treasurer and the staff will serve with requested information from the books for such audits.
- The auditors shall not receive a fee. The expenses for traveling, accommodation and meals for one auditor in relation to the audits and the presentation of the audit results shall be refunded by IFCM according to the usual rules for the refunding of expenses, under the condition that there is a funding in relation with the event at which the General Assembly will be hosted.

**Candidates to the internal financial auditor are asked to submit:**

1. A short CV with a highlight on your financial work background.
2. Picture.
3. A short text (100-150 words) on why you want to become IFCM's financial auditor.

Candidatures to the Internal Financial Auditor have to be submitted by 15 April 2026, at **00.00 GTM**. They have to be sent with all required documents to [office@ifcm.net](mailto:office@ifcm.net).

After closing of the process, all candidatures will be made public at least 90 days before the General Assembly. The elections will be carried out online together with the elections of the Board of Directors and President.
