This vibrant side programme brings together choirs from the Guangdong–Hong Kong–Macao Greater Bay Area, outstanding ethnic Chinese choirs, and exceptional children's and youth choirs from around the world, showcasing the rich diversity of choral traditions and cultures.

Coro de Câmara do Instituto Gregoriano de Lisboa, Portugal

Founded in 2014 and conducted by Filipa Palhares, this youth choir builds on the Instituto Gregoriano de Lisboa's long-established choral tradition. Today, its ensembles perform regularly both independently and in collaboration with Portugal's leading orchestras. Committed to promoting Portuguese contemporary music, the choir has premiered works by several renowned Portuguese composers.



Guizhou Village Choir, China

Founded amid Guizhou's vibrant rural cultural renaissance, the Guizhou Village Choir is a youth ensemble dedicated to preserving and promoting the Kam Grand Choirs (Grand Song of the Dong Ethnic Group), inscribed on UNESCO's Representative List of the Intangible Cultural Heritage of Humanity. Through its performances, the choir combines cultural preservation with artistic innovation, celebrating the rich traditions of the region's ethnic communities.

Bringing together local folk singers, university students, and cultural enthusiasts, the ensemble plays a leading role in the planning and promotion of Guizhou's village music culture while serving as an important ambassador for the authentic voices and musical heritage of the region.



Kyoto Youth Choir, Japan

Based in Kyoto, Japan's ancient capital, the Kyoto Youth Choir was founded in 2022 at the initiative of conductor Keishi Ito. Bringing together university students and young singers, the choir fosters artistic growth through workshops, training programmes, and regular performances. With around 30 active members, the ensemble presents a diverse repertoire that includes sacred music, folk song arrangements, contemporary works—particularly by Japanese composers—and choral arrangements of popular music.



Over the Rainbow Children's Choir, Shenzhen, China

"Ancient and Earth-Over: The Rainbow Multiethnic Children's Choir Concert" is a signature project for multi-ethnic children's choirs. It is hosted by the Shenzhen Green Pine Foundation, the Shenzhen Futian Over-the-Rainbow Ethnic Cultural Exchange Center, and the Shenzhen Concert Hall. The concert invites multi-ethnic children's choirs and ethnic cultural heritage groups from border areas. Traditional folk songs are arranged as children's choir pieces by conductor Hu Manxue, artistic director of the Shenzhen Over-the-Rainbow Children's Choir and conductor of the Shenzhen Golden Tree Multi-Ethnic Children's Choir.



South China Normal University Choir, Guangzhou, China

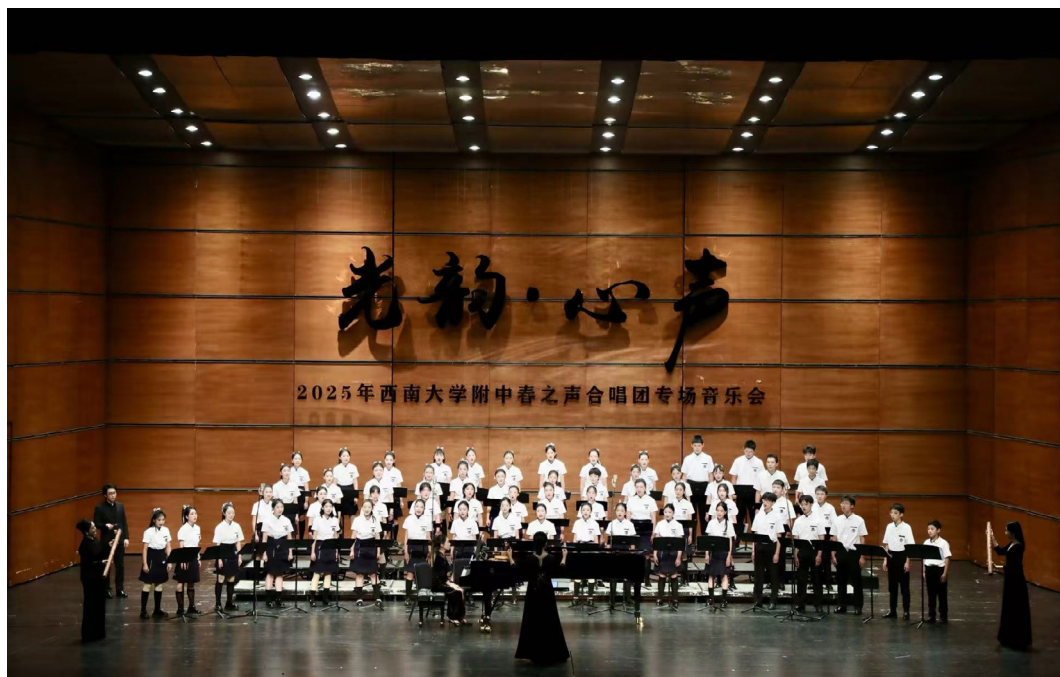
Founded in 1988 by the renowned composer Lei Yusheng, the South China Normal University (SCNU) Choir was initially led by conductor Lai Guangyi and is currently under the direction of Professor Su Yanhui. Over the years, the SCNU Choir has gradually developed a distinctive artistic style characterised by rigour, refinement, delicacy and passion. It has become increasingly outstanding thanks to its accumulated artistic achievements, rich expressiveness and innovative team spirit. In recognition of its high standard, the choir is acclaimed as "the representative of the highest level of choral art education" in Guangdong Province.



Spring Voice Choir of the High School Affiliated to Southwest University, Chongqing, China

The Spring Voice Choir of the High School Affiliated to Southwest University is an award-winning youth choir and a designated Municipal Student Arts Ensemble of Chongqing.

In 2023, the choir was recognised as a National First-Class Ensemble at the National Youth Choral Festival for its performances of *Red, Yellow, Blue and Green* and *Time*. The following year, it won First Prize at the Hong Kong International World Youth Choir Festival and later received First Prize in the Senior High School Division at the 10th Chongqing Secondary School Arts Festival.



Wuhan Renwen Philharmonic Choir, Wuhan, China

The Renwen Philharmonic Choir was founded in autumn 1999 as the school choir of Wuhan University's School of Humanities. Since then, it has grown into a tiered system spanning from preschool to elite choral ensembles. Dr. Zhou Kai is the Artistic Director and Dr. Mao Yong is the Choral Academic and Pedagogical Director. The Renwen Philharmonic Treble Choir (RPTC) was founded in 2013. Since then, it has focused on choral music, teaching young choristers self-directed learning, teamwork, performance, artistic appreciation, and personal cultivation.



The **Liping County Village Song Choir** will perform the Dong ethnic group's Grand Song in the reception hall of Macau Cultural Centre before the Opening Ceremony. Don't miss it!

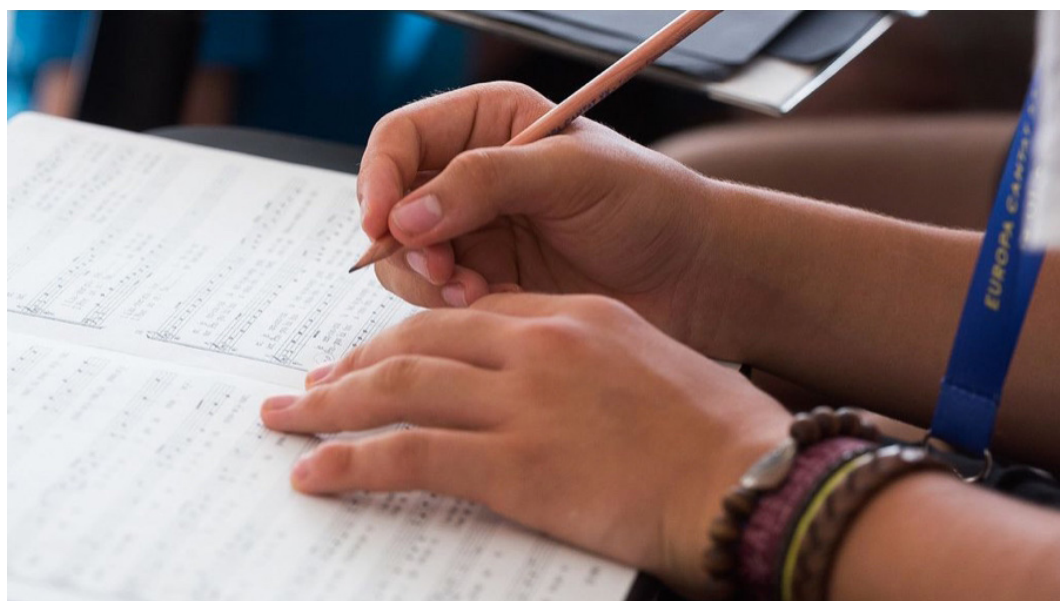

European Choral Association (ECA): EUROPA CANTAT 2027 unveils its international atelier programme

From **9–15 August 2027**, around **3,000 singers** will gather in **Liepāja, Latvia**, for the EUROPA CANTAT 2027 International Choral Festival, featuring **more than 35 ateliers** for singers and choirs of all experience levels.



Led by renowned conductors, the ateliers will explore a broad spectrum of choral music, from Renaissance and Classical repertoire to contemporary works, opera, jazz, pop, rock, and choreographed vocal performances.

The programme includes internationally acclaimed choral leaders such as **Sofi Jeannin**, **Jim Daus Hjernøe**, **Elisenda Carrasco i Ribot**, **Jaan-Eik Tulve**, **Petra Grassi**, the vocal ensemble **Rajaton**, and Latvian composer **Ēriks Ešņvalds**, one of today's most performed contemporary choral composers.

Federació Catalana d'Entitats Corals: Catalunya Prizes for Choral Compositions 2027

The call for the **11th International Prizes Catalunya for Choral Composition** of the [Federació Catalana d'Entitats Corals](#) (FCEC) is now open, for compositions based on Catalan text and harmonizations of traditional Catalan songs of medium difficulty, in two categories: mixed voices and equal voices, and which awards prizes worth 1,000 for each category. At



the same time, the [Orfeó Català](#) is also holding its **6th International Choral Composition Competition**. The winners will be announced in July 2027. The winning pieces will be published by the FCEC and distributed to members of choirs and to others by request. These works will also be performed at the Choral Music Fest on 1 March 2026 at the Palau de la Música Catalana.

The 2027 edition features an outstanding international faculty, with **Josep Vila Jover** (Spain) and **Elena Szuczies** (Germany) leading children's choirs; **Tori Longdon** (United Kingdom) and **Marleen de Boo** (Belgium) working with mixed youth choirs; and **Maud Hamon-Loisance** (France) and **Laura Jēkabsons** (Latvia) directing girls' choir workshops.

Alongside the musical programme, participants will enjoy concerts, international encounters, and opportunities to build lasting friendships across borders.
