



The International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM) was founded in 1982 for the purpose of facilitating communication and exchange between choral musicians throughout the world. Through its diverse range of projects and programs since that time, the IFCM is fulfilling its purpose.

In a world that develops more and more sophisticated weapons, that lives with the expansion of terrorism and fear, that disrespects and abuses the environment, choral singing can be one of the most powerful unifying forces between nations. Differences in culture, political ideology, race and language disappear when people sing together.

How can people who join together in song in harmony fight one another?

IFCM is member of IMC (International Music Council), official partner of UNESCO. The IMC recognizes that there are perhaps more people in the world participating in choral music than in any other group artistic activity. IFCM HISTORY

The International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM) works to strengthen cooperation between national and international organizations and individuals in all aspects of choral music.

The business of IFCM is run from offices established by the Executive Committee (ExCom) of the organization and approved by the Board of Directors.

The working language of IFCM is English.


