

General Assembly 2023: Timeline

November 2022

Launch of the call for candidates to the Board and Presidency, or as Financial Auditor. This call will include

- An overview on the current Board's mandate.
- A reminder on the new voting rights voted by the Membership in 2022.
- A reminder that each candidate must have paid their membership fee 2023 by January 20, 2023.
- A list of the documents each candidate should submit with their application (CV and vision for IFCM).

January 10, 2023

Deadline to apply as candidate to the Board and Presidency, or as Financial Auditor.

Mid-January 2023

The Membership will receive an invitation to the General Assembly together with the agenda and information about the online election.

This invitation will include

- A link to register to the Online Election
- Excerpts from the Bylaws and the Membership Policy Documents regarding the voting procedure and elections and how to ensure a fair geographical representation in the Board.
- A reminder that each member needs to have their membership in good standing by February 28, 2023, to vote.
- A form for choirs and associations to confirm who will represent them and carry their vote.
- The list of candidates and a link to their presentation.

The Membership will also receive a link to register to the General Assembly.

The agenda of the General Assembly will be available to all on the IFCM website and in the International Choral Magazine. Reminders of both Online Election and General Assembly will be published in the IFCMeNEWS and mailed out to the Membership.

February 28, 2023

Deadline to register for the Online Election and for the General Assembly.

Meeting of the Voting Committee and opening the results of the Online Election.

April 25, 2023

General Assembly in Istanbul and announcement of the results of the Online Election.
