IFCM 4TH INTERNATIONAL COMPETITION FOR CHORAL COMPOSITION

The International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM) announces the Fourth International Competition for Choral Composition, the chief aim of which is to promote the creation and wide distribution of new and innovative choral repertoire. Participation is open to composers of any nationality or age. The Competition is dedicated to choral compositions a cappella (SATB or divided into as many as eight parts, SSAATTBB) with a maximum duration of 5 minutes, specifically for medium to advanced choirs. The text of the composition, sacred or secular, in any language, written for the occasion or pre-existing should be in the public domain. If not, permission in writing must be obtained from the author or copyright holder of the text and must be enclosed with the entry form.

The entry fee is only US\$25.00! Apply between 1 April to 30 September 2019!

WORLD CHORAL EXPO 2019 | SAVETHE DATE

IFCM announces its second World Choral EXPO in Lisbon, Portugal 27 July - 1 August, 2019

The IFCM World Choral EXPO (WCE) is an international choral event which provides the opportunity for the global choral community (singers, conductors, composers, music educators, and professionals) to interact with and learn from world-renowned choirs and their conductors. The WCE 2019 will highlight three focus areas: choral music education, choral performance, and a choral exhibition. The inaugural WCE was held in Macau SAR (2015) and brought together over 10,000 participants with the common goal to sing 'songs of friendship and peace'. The theme for WCE 2019 is "Voices Meeting for a Better World." Don't miss this extraordinary possibility to work with celebrated choral personalities, to interact with likeminded choral musicians from around the world, and to experience some of the finest choral singing on the planet.

WORLD CHORAL DAY

The 2018 World Choral Day project involved a record number of event subscriptions (396) with the largest representation of countries in the history of the project (69). To mark the 100th anniversary of the ending of World War I, 2018 World Choral Day was broadened to include concerts between November 11 and December 16, 2018. With an enhanced website, easy-to-use entry protocol, robust search engine and event manager, and a tutorial video, 2018 World Choral Day provided a unique opportunity for choirs around the world to share their concerts on the most relevant social media platforms. Of particular note is the fact that there were 15 new countries from which there have never been World Choral Day events. Two new components were added to the 2018 World Choral Day project. A virtual choir comprised of 133 singers from eight countries, **VoxPopuli Virtual Choir**, conducted by Ana Maria Raga, performed the winning composition of the 2018 Concurso Internacional de Composición Coral Alberto Grau (*Nada Te Turbe* by Carlos Alberto Cordero). As well, a World Choral Day **Gala Concert** was held in Lisbon, Portugal, on November 20, 2018, featuring five local choirs.

12TH WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC (WSCM2020)

We are immensely grateful to all those who went to the effort of applying and hope we will be able to welcome many of you to Auckland to enjoy the Symposium.
