THE WORLD SYMPOSIUM ON CHORAL MUSIC 2023 GOES TO ISTANBUL, TURKEY

We are happy to announce that the World Symposium on Choral Music (WSCM), one of the biggest events of the International Federation for Choral Music, will be held in Turkey from 25th to 30th of April 2023 with the support of the Turkish Ministry of Culture and Tourism. The event will be organized by the Turkish representative of IFCM, the Choral Culture Association.

The event promotes artistic excellence, cooperation and exchange, by bringing together the finest choirs and choral leaders for performances, seminars, workshops, exhibitions, and choral reading sessions. The theme of 2023, "Changing Horizons", aims to introduce as many singing traditions as possible from across the globe. WSCM 2023 invites submissions for presentations that are rooted in the exploration of diverse singing styles and traditions within countries and/or regions, showcasing collective singing practices that represent varied social, ethnic, geographical, and/or cultural backgrounds, encouraging presentation proposals that align with the symposium theme. Moreover, choirs and vocal ensembles are encouraged to bring creative programs grounded in diversity through the inclusion of repertoire and performance practices that showcase different social, ethnic, geographical, and/or cultural backgrounds within each ensemble's region.

IFCM announces a proposal call to host the **World Symposium on Choral Music** in **2026**. This triennial symposium is the prime global event in the international choral calendar. It draws together the world's leading musicians, choirs, vocal ensembles, conductors, composers, clinicians, and arts administrators for a superlative experience of concerts, workshops, seminars, presentations, and networking opportunities.

IFCM has held 11 symposia in 14 world-class cities over the past 35 years. The first WSCM was held in Vienna in 1987, followed by Stockholm/Helsinki/Tallinn in 1990; Vancouver, 1993; Sydney, 1996; Rotterdam, 1999; Minneapolis, 2002; Kyoto, 2005; Copenhagen, 2008; Puerto Madryn, 2011; Seoul, 2014; Barcelona, 2017; (Auckland, 2020, canceled). IFCM policy states that locations will generally alternate between the six continents. The next WSCM (2023) will be held in Istanbul, Turkey, from 25-30 April 2023.

Hosting a World Symposium brings high profile and prestige to the host city/country. The benefits accrue not only to the city and presenting partners, but to the musical growth and boosted economy of the region. If you and your organization/institution are interested in hosting the 2026 symposium, please examine the guidelines **HERE**, which provide essential information about hosting a WSCM, a list of requirements that will need to be considered, and details on the conference setup and the responsibilities of the host organization.

The proposal must come from a national organization, institution, or consortium. A major partnership with other entities, such as city/regional government and convention tourist bureau, is highly recommended.

Timeline:

- 15 September 2022: Closing date for Proposal Applications
- October 2022: Short-listed proposals selected by the IFCM Board
- November January 2022: IFCM delegation will meet with the finalists and visit the proposed site.
- End of January 2023: IFCM Board selects the host of the 14th IFCM World Symposium on Choral Music 2026, followed by the official announcement of the WSCM2026 host.



UPDATES ON THE KOREAN FEDERATION FOR CHORAL MUSIC

The Korean Federation for Choral Music (KFCM) was established in 1976 for the expansion and globalization of the Korean choral music. KFCM joined the International Federation for Choral Music (IFCM) in 2005. Here are some updates on the Federation that hosted the World Symposium on Choral Music in Seoul in 2014 and that just elected a new President for the next three years.

Dr. ChangHoon Park was elected 16th President of KFCM on May 28, 2022. For the past three decades, Dr. Park has established himself as a leader of the Korean choral society. He was the director and conductor of Seoul Metropolitan Chorus and the Seongnam City Chorus. Dr. Park has administrative experience as he served as the president of the Korean Universities Choral Federation, president of the Korean Choral Directors Association, director of the Korean Church Music Association, and vice president of KFCM.

Currently, he is the professor of conducting at the Presbyterian University and Theological Seminary. He conducts the Zion Choir at the Somang Presbyterian Church and the Seoul Moffett Choir. He has also been the founder and director of the Seoul Oratorio Festival for the past 26 years.

KFCM will expand the base of Korean choral music to the world under his guidance. Congratulations to Dr. ChangHoon Park.
