FIRST MEETING OF YOUNG IFCM

The first online meeting of the **YOUNG IFCM Youth Committee** was an exciting and productive gathering of young choral music enthusiasts and professionals. The meeting took place on 7 August 2023 in an online format to accommodate the global nature of the committee members and ensure everyone's participation. The primary objectives of the meeting were to introduce the committee members to each other, discuss the committee's mission and goals, and outline the plan for upcoming projects and activities. The committee discussed and clarified their shared mission and goals, focusing on empowering and engaging youth in choral music activities and





advocating for their inclusion and representation. The members collaboratively brainstormed and discussed potential projects and activities to be undertaken by the committee. In order to facilitate effective implementation of the projects, during the next meeting members will make decisions about roles and responsibilities based on their interests, strengths, and expertise.

This inaugural meeting generated several positive outcomes, including:


- Enhanced camaraderie and connection among committee members





Let's get emotional!

During the World Symposium on Choral Music 2023 in Istanbul, Jean Sturm, Executive Director of Musica International (www.musicanet.org), presented "Building a concert program using online choral resources: the Musica project". Interesting questions came up, such as "Can I search for sad pieces in Musica?" On Facebook, a choir conductor was looking for "a piece that would convey anxiety/worries". Another conductor needed a happy song to end a middle-school choir concert.

Is there a place where you can search for choral scores using only the emotion the work might convey? YES! A structured database as detailed as Musica International is ideal for searching scores which fit such a purpose.

Go to www.musicanet.org, enter a word identifying an emotion (*anxious, happy, sad*, etc.) in the field <Words or title or Keywords or Genre/Style/Form>. You will get dozens of results



for *anxious* and even hundreds for *happy* and *sad*. Search for *fear* and you get more than 800 results: for *anger*, more than 200 results, and for *weep*, more than 900 results. You can then ask for additional criteria such as voicing, difficulty for singers, language, duration, and more. Remember that all IFCM members get **Unrestricted Privileged Access to the Musica International** database!
